EVALUATION FOR LIFE EXPERIENCE CREDITS

Traditional colleges and accredited agencies have established the following guidelines for maximum credit received for life/work/ministries.

Associates Degree- 50% or 45 credit hours

COURSE MATERIAL & WORK INSTRUCTION

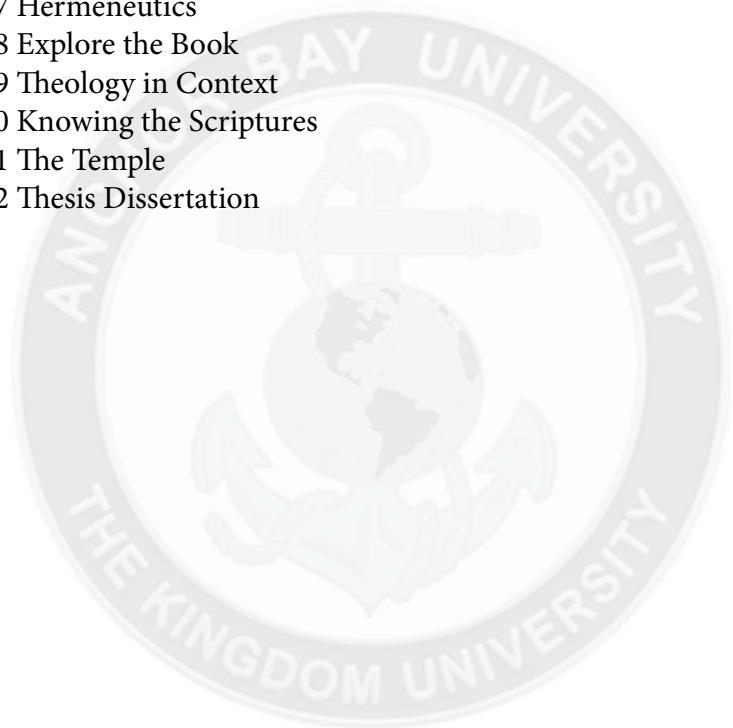

TUITION REFUND POLICY

A student may request a withdrawal in writing during the first 2 weeks and receive a full refund. After that date, the following refund policy applies: A. within 30 days of enrollment 80% refund. B. 60 days of enrollment 50% refund C. Within 90 days of enrollment is 30% refund D. after 90 days from date of enrollment no refund.
